 - Most common issues: duplicate clients; double enrollments; password rests; questions related to services, adding programs and setting up training

 - 3) How to better coordinate with other agencies and coordinate the 'system' of success → possibly a person to spearhead this?
 - Met on 07/20 to narrow down recommendations and focus on one → Sent a letter to the mayor based on the narrowed down recommendation
 - Developed a 'system map of homelessness'
 - Three presentations made by Dani focusing on homelessness issues;
